- Issuance of No Objection Certificate in favour of -

The undersigned is directed to refer to his letter No. 2105-30/ALS dated 12-11-97 on the above subject and to state that the State Govt. on the School Education Department has no objection to Bethany Mission School, Rupahar, P.O. Raiganj, Dt.-Uttar Dinajpur to affiliation of its Secondary Wing for the purpose of preparing its candidates and presenting them for the final secondary level examination of the C.B.S.E., New Delhi on the following terms and conditions

- 1) The State Govt. will not bear any financial liability of the School;
- 2) The School will not enhance tuition fee without prior express approval of the State Govt.;
- 3) The school will pay its teaching and non-teaching staff emoluments at a rate which will not be less than those of their counterparts with equivalent educational qualifications in state aided educational institutions of the State;
- 4) The School will provide for the contributory provident fund for the employees as prescribed under the relevant Provident Fund Act/Rules of the Govt. of India;
- 5) 10% (ten) percent of the new admission in the school each academic year will be allowed on the recommendation of the School Education Department and 50% of such students will have to be allowed to prosecute studies in the school free of any cost;
- 6) Violation of any of the conditions laid down in sub-para (3), (4) and (5) shall entail withdrawal of the 'No Objection' of the State Govt. with effect from the beginning of the academic year next to that in which such violation is committed.
